**AFTRA FELLOWSHIP AWARD 2019: CALL FOR NOMINATION**  
**(OPEN TO ALL AFRICAN COUNTRIES & INTERNATIONAL ORGANISATIONS)**

This is a call for the nomination of candidates to be considered for award of the **AFTRA Fellowship** at the 8<sup>th</sup> Annual Conference in Maseru, Lesotho, May 13-18, 2019. The nomination closes by January 31, 2019.

In 2017, AFTRA instituted the annual award to honour persons who have made remarkable contributions to the development of the teaching profession in any African country or Africa in general.

**GUIDELINES FOR THE NOMINATION**

1. All African countries and international organisations in Africa are eligible to make nomination.
2. One nominee only is allowed per country; therefore, the teaching regulatory authorities of each country must reach a consensus about a candidate before submitting a name to AFTRA.
3. An international organisation in the area of education may nominate one candidate only, which is not part of the nomination by each country.
4. A justification of the nomination in less than 250 words, together with the curriculum vitae and contact detail of the nominee, should be emailed to Fatouma Mohamed Ali ([fafi.med@gmail.com](mailto:fafi.med@gmail.com)) and copy Kelechi Anselem-Okorie ([kanselemokorie@yahoo.com](mailto:kanselemokorie@yahoo.com)).
5. The nominee must be a **QUALIFIED TEACHER** who has impacted extraordinarily on teacher education, professionalism and status at the national and/or international levels.

List of successful candidates shall be released after the AFTRA Executive Board meeting of February, 2019.
